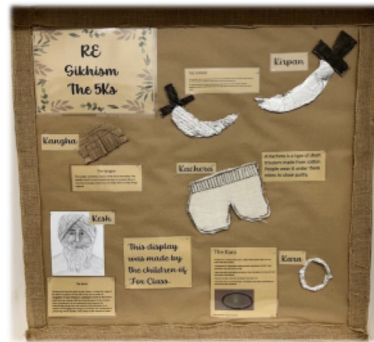
Rabbit Class
