Wed - Writing Club

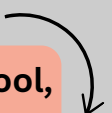
Thurs - Lego & games club

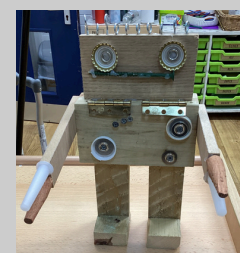
Take a look at our robots!
